Admissions

Saint Mark the Evangelist Catholic School offers classes for students in Pre-K (fully potty trained) through 8th grade. A wait list is established in January for families who are seeking to have their children attend our school. Families are notified by the end of February of their acceptance into the school. Active & contributing members of Saint Mark the Evangelist Catholic Church are given the first opportunity in being accepted into the school. Students transferring from other Catholic Schools are also considered, as well as Catholic families from other Parishes, upon available space.

Service Hours

Families with students enrolled in Kindergarten through 8th grade are asked to complete 20 hours of volunteer service each year.
